Workshop objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Raise awareness about gender violence and how it becomes accepted. 2. Motivate youth to identify and reject sexist attitudes.
Before starting this workshop	<p>If we're completing the entire guide, before starting the workshop we can ask students if they remember or have anything to say about the last workshop.</p> <p>We can also ask student if they'd like to guess at what we'll be talking about today based on the workshop title, "No means no". This slogan has been used in a number of campaigns against macho attitudes. We'll welcome any guesses student make, and get started on the workshop to see if any are correct.</p> <p>Before starting, we'll place our chairs in a semicircle, as though we were in an amphitheatre (we want to represent the workshop that appears in the video from the first activity).</p>
Activity 1	<p>I'll take a stand, too (10')</p> <p>Video and reflection activity. Activation activity.</p>
Activity 2	<p>The importance of language (25')</p> <p>Video and reflection.</p>
Activity 3	<p>The victim's pain (40')</p> <p>Put together a conceptual map or image summarizing macho violence.</p>

Activity 5	<p>Let's publish our impressions (5')</p>
