



## Forestry work to improve biodiversity and adaptation to climate change in the beech forests of Muntanya de Matagalls

Forestry work in Muntanya de Matagalls (24.5 ha of beech forest): Thinning and selection of remaining trees to promote a balanced forest structure and favour species and types of trees that are of interest for biodiversity. Habitat diversification actions through the creation, maintenance and expansion of clearings and tree treatments through selective felling, banding of different tree species and simulation of small disturbances.
