










Vall del Ges Livestock pilot Testing Space

A support framework ("test space") designed to facilitate the progressive integration of new farmers into the extensive livestock sector. It provides access to land, infrastructure, mentorship, advisory services, training, and territorial governance to reduce the challenges of starting a livestock operation.

The initiative in the Vall del Ges (Osona) includes a shelter, equipment and herd for a farm, specifically designed for dairy sheep grazing in open areas and surrounding forests.
